### ABSTRACT

This bulletin provides applated information on the Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP), a taxonomy for instructional programs at all levels developed by the U.S. Department of Education's Center for Education Statistics (CES) in 1979-80. The result\_of\_the\_contributions of\_state; federal; institutional; and association representatives and the empirical examination of reported data, this revised CIP\_structure is intended to reflect the continuing changes in postsecondary education program offerings, and it replaces the original 1981 publication. Introductory material includes a table summarizing the changes from the 1981 CIP to the 1985 CIP and detailed lists of items that were revised, added, or deleted as a consequence of the 1985 revision. These items included 116 instructional programs deleted from CIP because they were duplicative or did not exist; 40 programs added to CIP as a result of write-ins.on\_the\_Higher\_Education\_General\_Information\_Survey and Vocational Education Data System questionnaires, or information obtained from states, institutions, and associations for new and emerging programs; 7 codes revised to accommodate groups of similar programs; and 42 titles revised to incorporate the most current language in each field. The revised CIP lists a total of 1,091 programs organized in hierarchical order under 50 broad subject headings. The program code and title are included for each entry. (KM)

1985 Update

The Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP), developed by the U.S. Department of Education's Center for Education Statistics (CES) in 1979-80, was updated for the first time in 1985. CIP is a taxonomy for instructional programs at all levels. It is used in all CES surveys and is the accepted government standard for education information surveys.

In 1979-81, when CIP was developed and published, CES assured the education community that CIP would be updated periodically. CIP is intended to reflect the continuing changes for postsecondary education program offerings. Since first published, CIP has been used by CES in the Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS). and the Vocational Education Data System (VEDS); by other organizations, such as the Office for Civil Rights, Office of Vocational and Adult Education, and National Occupational Information Coordinating Committee: and by State agencies and national associations. CIP's use has been extensive enough so its completeness and relevance can be analyzed. For example, a review of HEGIS and VEDS data confirmed that most programs in CIP existed. "Write-ins" for programs not in CIP indicated new and emerging programs.

The CIP update will be used in CES' Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). The Carl Perkins vocational education legislation specifies the use of CIP in IPEDS vocational education surveys.

The CIP update was accomplished with help from State, Federal, institutional, and association representatives. The revised CIP is the result of their contributions and the empirical examination of reported data.

This bulletin includes the following four lists: (1) Instructional programs deleted from CIP, (2) programs added to CIP, (3) revised codes, and (4) revised titles. The CIP structure reflects all the updates and replaces

the one published in 1981. Each list gives more details on the changes explained here:

January 1987

List 1 gives 116 codes and titles deleted from the original CIP. Programs were deleted because they were duplicative or did not exist. When duplicative programs were found, one program was deleted. For example, 02.0306 Food Technology was deleted and 15.0602 Food Processing Technology remained. If data suggested that programs did not exist, such as 07.0706 Mail and Order Clerk, or 23.0901 Rhetoric, they were deleted. These deletions reduced the number of programs in CIP 10 percent.

List 2 gives 40 codes and titles added to the original CIP. Additions came from write-ins on HEGIS and VEDS survey questionnaires. When a number of institutions reported awards in programs not in CIP, the programs were added. These include 15.0405 Robotics Technology, 18.1030 Sports Medicine, and 30.0801 Mathematics and Computer Science. Also, programs such as 13.1321 Computer Education, 09.0801 Telecommunications, and 17.0410 Sign Language Interpreting were added on the basis of information from States, institutions, and associations for new and emerging programs. These additions are for 4 percent of the 1,091 programs in the updated CIP, for a net reduction of 6 percent.

List 3 gives 7 revised codes for CIP programs. The revisions were made to accommodate groups of similar programs. For example, in the public health area, 18.0601 Epidemiology was changed to 18.2202 so it would be in the category with other public health programs. These changes affected less than 1 percent of all CIP programs.

List 4 gives the 42 revised titles. These changes were made to incorporate the most current language in each field. Examples include 19.0212 Ultrasound Technology to Diagnostic Medical Sonography; and 17.0513 Ward Clerk to Health Unit Coordinating. Other changes in titles were made to provide consistency to the overall structure of CIP titles. These title changes affected only 4 percent of CIP programs.

No deleted codes were reassigned to new programs, and changes were kept to a minimum. The attached table provides a summary of changes from CIP-1981 to CIP-1985.

A new edition of A Classification of Instructional Programs is scheduled to be published in spring 1987. It will include all new, revised, and unchanged program definitions.
